With school resuming this week and many of our fellow parishioners returning from holidays, it is timely to ask, are you a traveller or a tourist? You see, there is a difference!

A traveller is a person who is interested in unfamiliar settings and wild encounters that enlarge their perspective. Throughout history, we read about people who set off in search of adventure and experience. These are the people who write books about their adventures and stimulate the imagination of others. A traveller takes risks, plunges into diverse cultures, and seeks to learn local customs. Unplanned experiences are the traveller's norm, sometimes involving challenging exploits. Travellers eat whatever food is placed before them. They aim to learn as much of the language as possible. **Shopping for souvenirs plays no part in their ventures!**

On the other hand, tourism is a spectator sport often full of contrived, prefabricated experiences. Usually, a tourist is a pleasure seeker who passes through different exotic experiences only to return to a comfortable bed at night. In that comfortable bed, a tourist is protected from the noise, the smells, the food and the customs of the local people. Tourists expect interesting things to happen to them. *A tourist goes sightseeing!*

In the big picture, does it really matter? Well, in this weekend's Gospel, we hear the very familiar story of the Good Samaritan, and it contains two types of people - travellers and tourists. The first two, the priest and the Levite, were merely tourists; they were sightseeing from the safety of the other side of the street. The traveller in the story was the Samaritan because he was the only one who was prepared to be involved in the great drama of life.

In our world of mass tourism, we are all conditioned to stay on the "safe side of the street" and sometimes view the great drama of life as simply sightseers. Viewed from "the safe side of the street", a lot of life simply becomes photo opportunities where we are protected from any awkward or inconvenient involvement. The Good Samaritan, on the other hand, is definitely a traveller because he was prepared to take a risk and plunge headfirst into the drama of life with all its messiness and uncertainties. In doing so, the Good Samaritan becomes for us here in our Sunshine Catholic Parish an example of Gospel charity in action.

So, as you start another week, on this journey of life that God has set you on, are you an *engaged traveller or merely a tourist passing through?*
