▶The Parish Liturgy Committee acknowledged the many parishioners who generously ensure, through their ministries, that our Masses are celebrated each week with dignity. With the generosity of fellow parishioners as a foundation, next year the Liturgy Committee wants to build upon and strengthen our liturgical life through forward planning and providing in-service opportunities, especially for our Readers, Eucharistic Ministers, Musicians, etc. The next meeting of the Parish Liturgy Committee will be on Saturday, 4 February.

## Liturgy Update

The Parish Liturgy Committee held its meeting last Saturday morning. After the opening prayer and welcome, Fr Brannelly invited Michael Fitzpatrick to chair the meeting. Acknowledging that this was the first meeting there were many ideas discussed, and in due course will be addressed. The following are some of the main items that were actioned.

►The Christmas Mass Times were tabled and agreed upon.

Christmas Eve - Saturday, 24 December

Christmas Day - Sunday, 25 December Maroochydore 6.30am and 9.00am Buderim 9.30am Coolum Beach 7.30am

- ►With the short liturgical season of Advent beginning on the weekend of 26/27 November, discussion revolved around how to ensure that this short four week season of "awaiting" could be highlighted. The change in the liturgical colour to purple immediately sets the tone. The lighting of the Advent Wreath replaces the Penitential Rite at the start of Mass and there is no Gloria until after Christmas. It was agreed that, during Advent, scripture and music should have a special focus on "Emmanuel God is with us". For the recessional, the musicians will lead "Wait for the Lord" to reinforce the Advent theme of waiting.
- ▶The new weekday and weekend Mass times in our parish were discussed, and some of the liturgical and community opportunities were explored. The new Mass times will ensure that, into the future, our Mass times are sustainable and the locations strategically support the evangelisation goals of our parish.
- ►The training of the junior ministers who serve on the altar continues with Fr William. The plan is to support and expand this ministry into the new year.
- ►Our four faith communities are blessed with dedicated and generous musicians and singers who, each week, give of their
