Advent Reflection

As we approach the second week of Advent, it is worthwhile to pause and consider the importance of this time of preparation and watchful waiting. Too often, the season of Advent is overshadowed by the "holiday season" as we move too quickly into celebrating Christmas. By the time that the actual solemnity of Christmas arrives, many of us are burned out. We are already tired of all the "Christmas hype."

As we draw close to the end of the school year, this week, many families set off for holidays that were planned over the past months. We wait in eager anticipation of that special trip or outing and catching up with friends and family. Whatever it is that we will be doing takes careful planning. We don't just book a lastminute flight to some place we've heard is good, without planning or preparing in some way. We do some research on accommodation options, look up places of interest in the area, make advance bookings and look at images of the place we will be visiting (How did we survive without Google?). If we are staying home, we may be making other plans of things to do, menus for Christmas lunch or people to catch up with. While this can lead to Christmas burnout, if done right, we can get as much out of the planning or anticipation as the arrival of the actual event.

The word advent comes from the Latin for "coming" or "arrival". What is the arrival we are awaiting? It is a time of preparation for Christmas, the first coming of God's Son. It is also a season when we are directed to Christ's second coming at the end of time. It is a season of joyful hope, a time of preparation and waiting. This season is not just about preparing for the birth of Christ at Christmas, but for the Christ who is continually being born in our lives and in the church every day.

As we step into the holiday season, let us focus on the coming of Christ and slow down to appreciate the time of preparation and anticipation that Advent provides. While the preparation for family events and holidays is good, we also need to prepare ourselves spiritually for the coming of Christ. The liturgies of the four Sundays of Advent help to guide and focus our attention on Christ's coming. It is an enormous challenge to remain faithful to the Advent season when we are surrounded by a society which does not take the time to reflect and prepare as the Church calls us to do. As followers of Christ, we need to do things a bit differently. I encourage families and individuals to make Advent a time of prayer and eager anticipation of the coming of Jesus into our lives, homes and hearts.

Let us pray that Advent season will renew us and help us to be an example of patience, silence, and joy to our hurried society.
